

Family Volunteer Hours

Parental involvement at St. Patrick Cathedral School is vital to a child's education, strengthens the community, and helps keep the school's operating costs to a minimum. Each family (K-8) at St. Patrick Cathedral School is required to complete twenty (20) hours of family volunteer hours. All hours must be completed by parents, guardians, or close family members. Hours may be acquired by volunteering for many of the school functions that are held throughout the year, helping in the cafeteria, helping in the gently used uniform store, etc.

To insure that we have participation at all events, and so our families have an opportunity to enjoy all events as well, we suggest dividing the twenty hours into the two semesters. Ten hours the first semester and the other ten hours the second semester

However, we understand that some of our families may have difficulty completing their volunteer hours. In hopes of making it an easier process, we have provided two alternatives:
